It truly is a small world. At East City Flowershop we would like to thank those of you who have been flexible with the flower and plant choices following the tropical storms in Florida. Some of our deliveries where late or re-routed because of airport shut downs in the US. Times like this make us aware of the impact that serious weather conditions have on us all.

Glorious Sweet Smelling Paperwhites

Many plants have become associated with the holiday season, brightening our homes during the cold December days. Pure white Paperwhite narcissus are very easy to bloom indoors for the holidays.

The most popular way to grow Paperwhites is to force them to bloom indoors during the winter. Fill a shallow bowl, pot, or container part way with decorative stones. Plain stones, gravel, and even soil works too. Set



Paperwhite bulbs onto the stones, pushing them down just far enough so the bulbs are supported in an upright position. Put several of them together. Don't worry about crowding.

Add water just to the bottom of the bulb. Put them in a cool dark place for one to two weeks. When the roots have begun to take hold, and the plant has sprung from the bulb, take the pot out into a brightly lit room. Four to six weeks later, your Paperwhites will be in bloom.

Make sure to plant them in succession, so you will have pots of Paperwhites blooming all winter long!

After blooming, cut the flower and stem off. Do not cut back the leaves. Put them in a sunny window and transplant them outdoors when the weather permits. It will take two or three years before they will bloom again.
