
FLOWER TALK -GREEN EDITION

rich soil supports a healthier ecosystem. The City of Peterborough collects green waste from flower shops all year 'round. Thank you City! Meanwhile, our garbage is carefully sorted to ensure minimal contamination of recyclable materials, further supporting responsible waste disposal.

Recycling plastics is another key focus. We follow strict guidelines to ensure plastics are cleaned, sorted, and sent to appropriate facilities. This reduces the strain on natural resources and minimizes the impact of plastic waste on the environment. By



participating in local recycling programs, we contribute to a circular economy where materials are repurposed and reused. Pido Road sees us regularly!

Beyond traditional recycling, we also take pride in collecting specific items like bread tabs, milk bags, and pop can rings. These items, though small, can make a big difference when gathered in bulk. Bread tabs are sent to St James Church for their collect, while milk bags can be woven into durable mats for humanitarian projects. Pop rings are collected to prevent wildlife harm and one of our PickOntario suppliers takes them for projects at his children's school.



These initiatives not only reduce waste but also foster community involvement and awareness about the importance of sustainability. We purchase carbon offset credits to balance the shipping demands flowers require.



By embracing these practices, we aim to lead by example, showing how businesses can balance their operations with environmental responsibility. Together, small actions can add up to significant positive change. As Kermit says "it's not easy being green" but we are doing our best. Happy 2025!
